'Let your ART shine' Art Contest Rules

Visual Arts

- Entries must be <u>no larger</u> than ONE 12" x 12" sheet of paper (including mat).
- Presentation points will only be given to entries that are mounted on colored paper or a mat.
- Works of art must be flat and may not exceed more than 1/4th inch thickness.
- All types of drawings are acceptable including pencil, charcoal, chalk, ink, crayon, colored pencil, paint, pastels, and any other medium used for drawing and sketching
- Work must be 100% student effort, or it will be judged at 50%

Photography/Digital Art

- Only pictures taken by the student are acceptable.
- Prints must be mounted on some type of card stock or poster board.
- Entries must be no larger than ONE 12" x 12" sheet of paper (including mat).
- Digital composition allowed
- Minor scrapbooking allowed, like captions or sayings, and minor layering
- Work must be 100% student effort, or it will be judged at 50%

3-D Paper Art (*note special submission rules for 3-D entries)

- Any type of recyclable paper is allowed
- Must not exceed 12" x 12" x 12" cubic space **ENTRY MAY BE DISQUALIFIED IF BIGGER THAN STATED
- Submit **picture of entry** with form, designated day for judging will be announced and entry will be accepted at that time

Work Not Accepted:

- Sculptures, ceramics, jewelry, or other 3-D work
- Any Visual Art entries on lined paper will not be accepted

*Literature will be included in a separate contest (Writers of the Future Contest – January)

**Musical Compositions will be included in a separate contest (Talent Show - April)

Judging

- Entries will be judged anonymously by the following categories: **Creativity** (25 pts.), **Presentation** (25 pts.), **Interpretation of Theme** (25 pts.), **Artistic Merit** (25 pts.).
- Please **DO NOT** put your name on your item of entry; your name should be on the entry form only.
- Entries without completed entry forms may be disqualified.
- Please check entry forms for accuracy before you turn them in, so they can be judged in the right category.
- Entry forms that are not accurate may be disqualified.

ENTRY FORMS ARE AVAILABLE FROM TEACHERS OR SCHOOL OFFICE

Only one submission per category per person will be allowed
