Any student who swears or uses profane or foul language will be pulled to level two (orange) and both parents will be notified. If it happens a second time, they will be pulled to level 1 (red) and discipline policy will be followed.

Any student using indecent exposure will have both parents notified. 1st and second grade will pull to red. 3rd to 6th will be suspended.

No student will touch any other student in private and inappropriate places. 1st and second grade will be pulled to red. 3rd through 6th will be suspended. Parents will be contacted. Any exception will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

There will be no boy girl relationships or Public Displays of Affection (PDA) between boy and girl. 1st offense: Each individual situation will be evaluated and a decision will be made as to how it should be handled. Severe cases may result in suspension or expulsion.

Respect

Students will be kind and respectful to each other, any physical fighting will be handled at the discretion of the teacher.
