drought: a long season of no rain

jet stream: a high-speed wind current moving from west to east around the earth

arid: dry

barometer: an instrument for measuring air pressure

hygrometer: an instrument for measuring humidity

condensation: the forming of tiny droplets of water as water vapor cools

Celsius scale: a scale for measuring temperature on which 0 degrees marks the freezing point of water and 100 degrees marks the boiling point

Fahrenheit scale: a scale for measuring temperature on which 32 degrees marks the freezing point of water and 212 degrees marks the boiling point

squall: a brief, strong windstorm, often with rain or snow

climatic: having to do with the climate
