

Student Body Officers Information for 2020-2021 School Year!

To be able to run for an office for the 2020-2021 school year your child has:

- **Student has maintained a grade point average of 3.8 or above.**
- **Student has great citizenship (No more than 5 absences or tardies in one quarter)**
- **Student had no card pulls to a 3 (yellow) and not more than 2 card pulls to a 4 for the entire year**
- **Student is not a summer school candidate as of the Spring CAT's**
- **Student carries the same character qualities as a "Hope of the Order Award" applicant****

All candidates will be required to complete these steps:

1. Qualify as per the qualifications in the above list.
2. Have a letter of recommendation from a past teacher.
3. Write a 5 paragraph essay as to why you are the best candidate for the job.
4. Prepare a video to be shown during elections. (Candidates may do a group video.)
5. Make 4 posters to hang around the school to advertise you as a candidate.

Student Body Offices:

President: The president is the head of the student body officers. They are to help the entire student body with morale, and good character. The president will have a lot of responsibility throughout the school year and will need to be the type of student with good organization, and leadership skills to stay on top of their grades and presidential responsibilities!

Vice-President: The vice president will work closely with the president to make our school a great place to be! The vice president will take the president's place in the case of the president's absence. The vice-president will also hold a lot of responsibility, and will need to be a great leader with exceptional character traits!

Secretary: The secretary is the book keeper and will keep things organized. They will work with the advisors and the other student body officers to make the school year great. The secretary will also be held to high standards of great character!

Historian: The historian's responsibility consists of many things, but their primary responsibility will be to document the activities that take place this school year. They will need to have access to a camera, preferably digital. The historian needs to have high standards, excellent grades, and great character!

Activities Coordinator: The activities coordinator will work closely with the teachers to plan school wide activities. The activities coordinator will also help plan and coordinate our "Pep assemblies" and our High Honor Roll parties. This position requires a lot of extra work and responsibility; the activities coordinator must be the type of student that will be able to handle the extra work without their grades dropping below the 3.7 level. The activities coordinator must have exceptional behavior and leadership skills.

Parents should be aware of the \$85.00 expense. (to be determined based on cost of jacket, shirts, etc.) This will be added to tuition and school fees the first month of the 2020-2021 school year, if your child is elected to a position. The expense covers pictures, jackets, and shirt logos.

**"The Hope of the Order Award" will only be given to students graduating from 6th grade but we feel that anyone who is a Student Body Officer should meet the same qualifications. Someone who is "The Hope of the Order"; makes a place for others, watches out for and takes care of their fellow classmates, is an example for the entire student body, strives for excellence in all areas, is close to and knows Heavenly Father as well as those over them, and has the ability to bring the spirit of the Lord into the classroom and in every situation they participate in.
